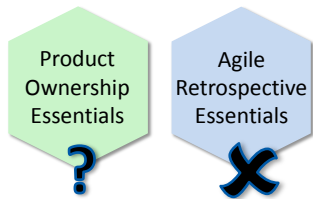


Agile Essentials

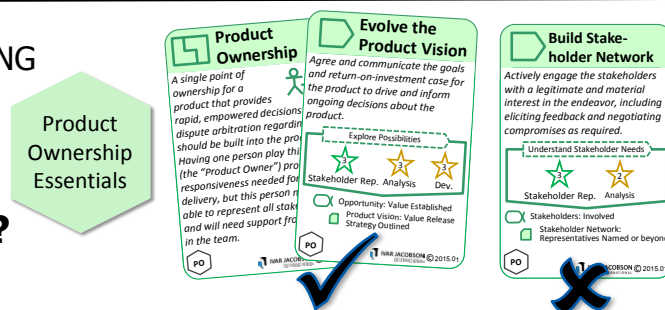

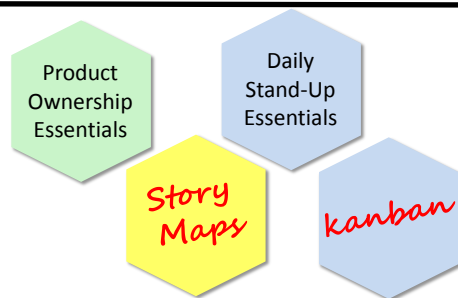

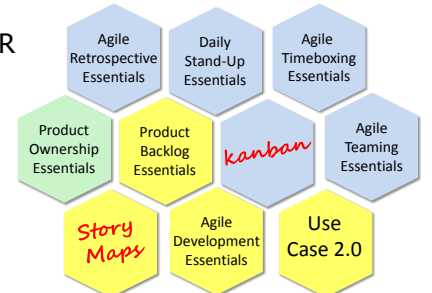
